

Nuclear Bomb Creation and Usage

Your first step to creating a nuclear bomb is to find a high amount of radioactive material. For example, uranium and plutonium both work. Only Uranium-235 works, most other variations are less fissile and will not work in nuclear bombs.

Plutonium is obviously a better choice. However, it only is created as residue from other nuclear reactions. Therefore, it may be harder to get than uranium unless you have uranium already.

Create two or more different pieces of your chosen material, and create a bomb that's triggered by detonating conventional explosives so the pieces fly together and reach a critical mass. 


Fun Things to Do in Benji HQ



Chapter 4: Benji Island Survival Guide

So, you're wondering about the mystical location of Benji City, Benji Island, and the locations in this world. You're wondering about the layout of Benji Island, because it isn't clear.

Well, fear not, because here is a map of Benji Island, for you to view at your leisure!




The Locations of Benji City

Benji Island

Benji Island is an island in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean, connected to the rest of the world through phone lines, satellites, and a boat route leaving from Grace Bay on alternating thursdays.

Benji Island is positioned in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean. I'm sure you're all wondering where I can find exact coordinates, but Benji Island is so light it floats on the current! The exact position changes every day.



Benji City

Benji City is the main metropolis of Benji Island. Most residents of Benji Island live here, and the population of the city are mostly humans. Benji City is separated from the rest of the island through a river through Leafy Canyon which has perilous terrain which makes this route almost impassible. To combat this, the first mayor of Benji City, David Grace, made a tunnel that connects Benji City and Leafy Canyons. This tunnel is highly patrolled to prevent anyone coming who could be a threat to Benji City.

Benji City has a population of around 30,000 people, spread across the city with a radius of about 10 miles. The city is run by a republican government with elected representatives that vote on laws, or at least most people believe. The city may actually be more of a dictatorship instead, as the mayor gets absolute power over the city in "emergencies" - which don't have a clear definition (infamously, Mayor LaBelle declared an emergency over a missing bag of potato chips, taking absolute power and refusing to step down).

Leafy Canyons

Leafy Canyons is a forest filled to the brim with wild animals, leaves of poison ivy, dangerous canyons, and difficult terrain. In 1965, David Grace cleared out all the forest to the left of the Grace River, turning it into a clearing.

Chestnut Mountains

The Chestnut Mountains are a mountain range where many wild chestnuts grow. Although there is a tunnel under most of the mountains, they are controlled by Dr. Banana's militia and only allowed for use by Dr. Banana's allies.

The main Chestnut Mountain is to the north of the main mountain range, and was named for this because there has been a giant chestnut stuck on top of the peak for as long as anyone can remember. To the north is the Acorn Village and to the east is the Prison House.

The Acorn Village is a neutral village run by intelligent acorns. The Acorn Village is the second ever franchise of Wisconsin in a Building, with the first being in Lake Geneva.

The Prison House is a prison for the enemies of Dr. Banana. Bobby Banana was in charge of the Prison House until Benji killed Bobby Banana and freed the inhabitants.

Yellow Desert

The Yellow Desert is a desert located on the northwestern coast of Benji Island.

Lava Valley

Lava Valley is a hellish landscape set in the middle of Benji Island, heated by a portal above the island to Buttburner. The Lava Valley is the home of many part-time Buttburner residents on Benji Island. Lava Valley has some of the cheapest housing prices on Benji Island, so it has a few residents. Lava Valley is the source of Benji's power.

Volcanoes of Death

The Volcanoes of Death are an inlet in the middle of the Chestnut Mountains that are directly below the Buttburner portal. This caused many of the mountains to turn into volcanoes. This land is the source of Jordan's power.

Crystal Caves

The Crystal Caves are an underground cave system on the north of Benji Island bordering the Grace Sea. The Crystal Caves are a veritable maze of passages, and many natives of Benji Island have gotten lost in the caves. There are no natives to the Crystal Caves, but there is a small settlement in the middle of the cave system to help those who get lost in the caves. This is the source of Emily's power.

Isle of the Wet

The Isle of the Wet is a partly sunken island connected to Benji Island by a bridge. The Isle of the Wet has been raining for the past 700 years, with lightning strikes frequently - caused by a magnetic force field around the island. There are abandoned castles in the Isle of the Wet due to Benji City residents moving here and waiting for the rain to let out. This is the source of Jack's power.

Banana City

Banana City was formerly a banana plantation on the east side of Benji Island until 1965, when one of the bananas fell into a pit of radioactive waste, becoming Dr. Banana and turned the plantation into their own empire, Banana City.

Hallie Village

The Hallies are mutations of humans with double to triple the size of a regular human, growing up to 20 feet tall sometimes. This is the source of Hallie's power - Hallie was born here as a human and gained powers to turn into a Hallie and back whenever she wants.

Buttburner

Buttburner is a planet 300 million light years away from Earth. However, there is a portal above Lava Valley and the Volcanoes of Death that goes directly there. This portal is accessible in two ways - you can fly to the portal through a spaceship from Benji Island, or you can use a portal in the Acorn Village that, in exchange for a stick from every area on the island, will open a staircase to the portal.

The Politics of Benji City

Benji City is a republican representative government with a justice system run by individual judges, with no jury. This system is not used very much in other countries, but works fine for Benji City as it has a very small population.

Representatives in Benji City are elected in yearly democratic elections by every citizen of Benji City. There are 10 representatives elected yearly. Every year, the 10 oldest representatives leave and are replaced by the new ones, making the total 50 representatives at once. Representatives do not have to run for office. The 10 representatives with the most votes may choose if they want to be a representative, or if they will pass their spot to the next representative with the most votes.

Representatives in office get to vote on new laws, which can be created by anybody and sent through the mail to the Benji City Capitol Building. Each law is voted on by all representatives, with the current mayor getting a second vote in the case of a tie.

The mayor is elected by the representatives every year. The mayor must be a current representative. The mayor's job is to be the public figure of Benji City politics, as well as being able to temporarily claim dictatorship rights in case of emergencies.

The Council is a group of 3 people who were elected by the previous Council. This was established by the first mayor, David Grace, before he left office. He elected his 3 daughters as the first council. The council's job was to make sure the politics of Benji City reflected what they were originally intended to be. The current council is the 3 sons of the oldest of the three daughters; Jonah, Eli, and Isaiah. The council has the right to veto new laws if all 3 members of the Council agree.

Benji City's criminal justice system is carried out by judges, the 10 eldest representatives in office, as well as the eldest surviving former mayor. These judges get to individually decide amongst themselves (usually through a vote) which of the representatives will be in charge during each trial (the Judge). The other judges (The Jury) each vote "guilty" or "not guilty" on criminal justice cases, with Not Guilty winning ties.

Caesar Cipher

The Caesar Cipher is a cipher invented by Julius Caesar, who used it for private correspondence. You can encode a message with this cipher by taking every letter and moving it left or right a certain number of digits - if you are shifting right 3, A would become D, B would become E, C would become F, and so on.

Try decoding this message with the key of 13 (A becomes N, B becomes O, etc).

Vigenere Cipher

This cipher, although it provides better encryption than the other 3, is very difficult to learn. This cipher is a variation of the Caesar cipher where there are different shift amounts for each letter. For example, if your message is BANANA, and your key is DR, then you will shift the letter B ahead 4 places (D is letter 4 of the alphabet), the letter A ahead 18 places (R is letter 18 of the alphabet), the letter N ahead 4 places, A ahead 18 places, and so on until the message is completed.

For example, decrypting the message “Erqqrqv ruv ffr” with the key “DR” will require you to shift the letter E back 4 places, the letter R back 18 places, the letter Q back 4 places, and so on until the message is completed. Can you decode the message?

One-Time Pad

This cipher is so secure, it's literally impossible to break! This cipher is another variation of the Vigenere cipher. But in the One-Time Pad, the key is as long as the message.

For example, say the key is MINION. Encoding the message "BANANA" with the key MINION grants the response "NIAIBN". This is unique because, with the encoded message, the original message could be ANYTHING. Any combination of key and original message the same length could work. For example, encoding the message "DOCTOR" with the key "KUYPNW" also gets the response "NIAIBN". However, this code is only secure if you only use the key ONCE. If you have multiple messages with the same key, it's possible to figure out the answer.
